The Town of Fort Frances Municipal Emergency Control Group is continuing to monitor and take the necessary actions to ensure the protection of critical infrastructure, assets and properties directly affected by the high waters.

With this said, we have implemented the following closures effective today:

1. Front Street between Minnie Avenue and Williams Avenue
2. Calder Drive from the camping area around the loop by Vanjura Ball Diamond
3. Sorting Gap Marina Gas Docks

Sandbagging operations continue at the Public Works yard and volunteers are welcome to assist. We are currently operating Monday-Friday 9am-4pm. Volunteers are required to register with Town Staff at the Animal Shelter building.

We thank you for your patience and understanding and would like you to be reassured that we will continue to monitor the situation and work to keep the public informed through 93.1 The Border and our Town of Fort Frances social media.
