1.0 POLICY STATEMENT

Through their participation, it is anticipated that the student will gain a good understanding of the committee structure, its role in the framework of the municipal organization, and how it operates.

2.0 GUIDELINES

- a) Open to students of Grade 11 and 12
- b) Maximum of two students to be appointed to each appointed body
- c) Participation on the basis of regular attendance at meetings of the body to which appointed; the student may participate, when called upon by the presiding chairman, in discussions of agenda topics; rules of conduct as established by the committee, board or commission are to be strictly observed.
- d) Term of unofficial office to be December first to the end of the school term.
- e) Applications will be received by the Clerk in response to the public advertisement of positions available.
