Fort Frances has the good fortune to be granted **\$102,750** for projects within our community that align with the Moffat Family Fund purposes.

The Moffat Family Fund was established at The Winnipeg Foundation in December 2001. Over the past twenty years the Fund has granted more than \$80 million in Winnipeg, as well as in 12 other communities across Canada – Vancouver, Calgary, Edmonton, Prince Albert, Moose Jaw, Thompson, The Pas, Flin Flon, Kenora, Dryden, Fort Frances and Hamilton.

The Moffat Family Fund's primary goal is to support and advance the economic, social, physical and intellectual well-being of children and families, consistent with the vision and mission of the Moffat Family Fund.

The Moffat Family Fund Steering Committee ("the committee") invites registered charitable organizations within Fort Frances to submit project proposals and an application for funding from Monday January 16, 2023 to Friday March 24, 2023.

The Committee Review Process:

- ❖ Once all completed applications have been received, the committee will review and carefully assess and consider each application.
- ❖ The committee will then make their recommendations and present it to Council for their review and approval.
- ❖ The Winnipeg Foundation will be advised of the committee's and Council's chosen organizations by mid-April 2023.
- ❖ Once approval is obtained from the Winnipeg Foundation, award letters will be provided to the organizations.
- ❖ All organizations will be notified via letter or email of the result of their application.



- ❖ The chosen organizations will be invited to a Council meeting to be acknowledged and provided a cheque of the grant awarded to them (June to July 2023)

The funds awarded to the successful organizations are to be used for projects that will be of benefit directed specifically to the residents and families residing in Fort Frances.

Successful organizations will also be required to submit a short final report commenting on the impact of the project that they were able to complete for 2023, as a direct result of the awarded funds.

The final report must also include details of financial expenditures supported by invoices and/or receipts.

Failure to submit requested final reports by the due date will jeopardize future funding opportunities to the awarded organizations.
